

Materials: Faith Catcher Pattern, photocopies, white index paper, scissors, colored felt pens.

Preparation: Photocopy pattern onto white paper, one for each child.

Instruct each child in the following procedures:

- ✂ Cut out Faith Catcher on solid line.
- ★ Color each halloon with a different color felt pen.
- ★ Lay paper printed side down.
- ★ Fold Faith Catcher in half on dotted line. Open the paper.
- ✂ Fold paper in half in the opposite direction. Open the paper (sketch a).
- ★ Fold paper corners to the middle of back side of paper on dotted lines (sketch b).
- ★ Turn folded paper over and fold paper corners into the middle of square on dotted lines (sketch c).
- ✂ Fold paper in half. Open and fold in half in the opposite direction (sketch d).
- ★ Slip your thumb and pointer fingers into the

folded pockets of the game (sketch e).

- ✂ Move your fingers back and forth and side to side to make the game open and close.

To play game with a partner:

1. Place Faith Catcher on fingers and ask partner to pick a colored ballion.
2. Spell the color name while moving the catcher open for each letter. The catcher should remain open.
3. Have partner choose one of four words of faith. Open and close the catcher to spell out the word.
4. Partner chooses another word of faith. Take the catcher off fingers and open to read the verse printed under the word.
5. Play the game again, this time letting your partner move the catcher.
6. After playing several times, see if you can say the verse under the flags without looking at them!
